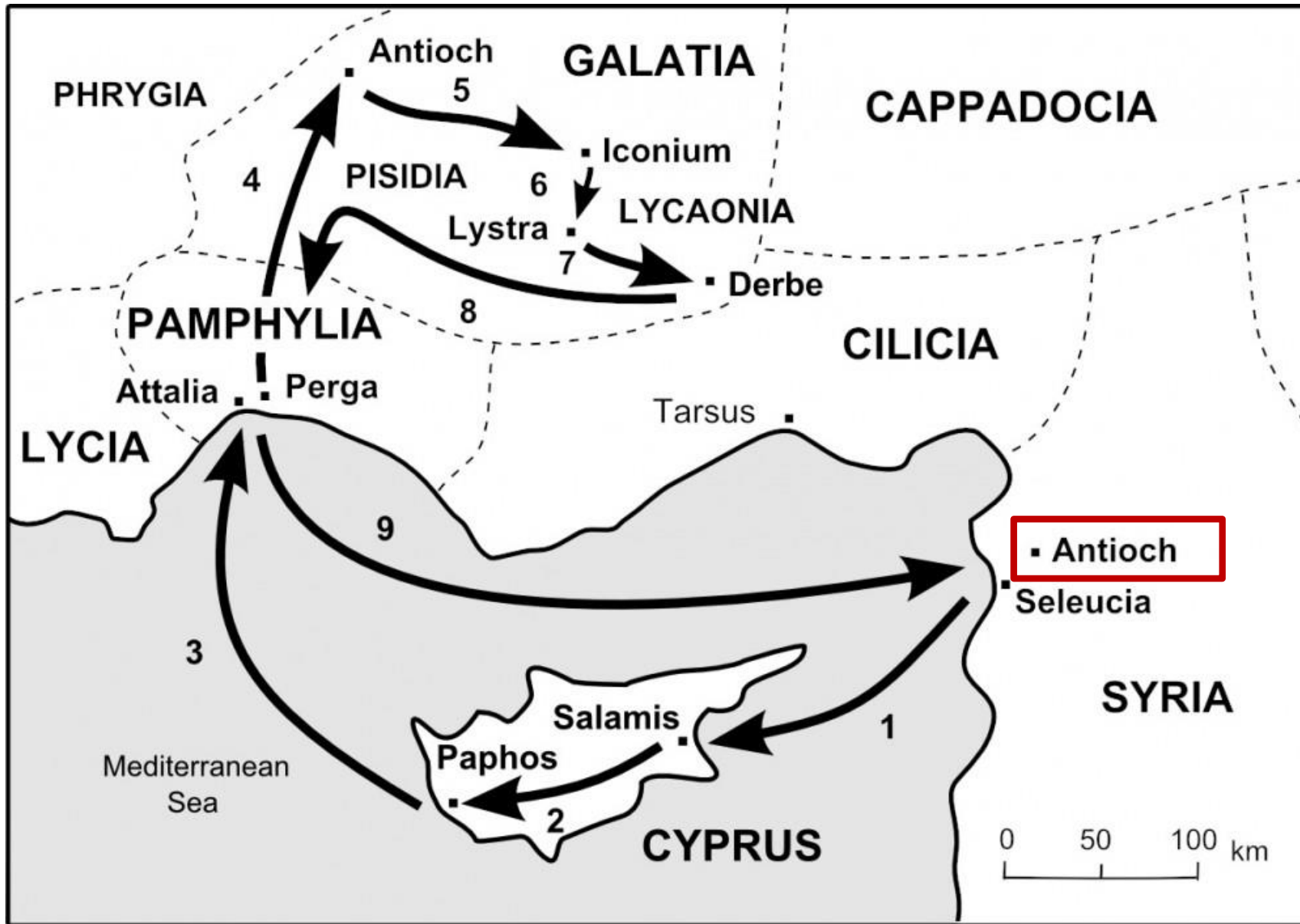

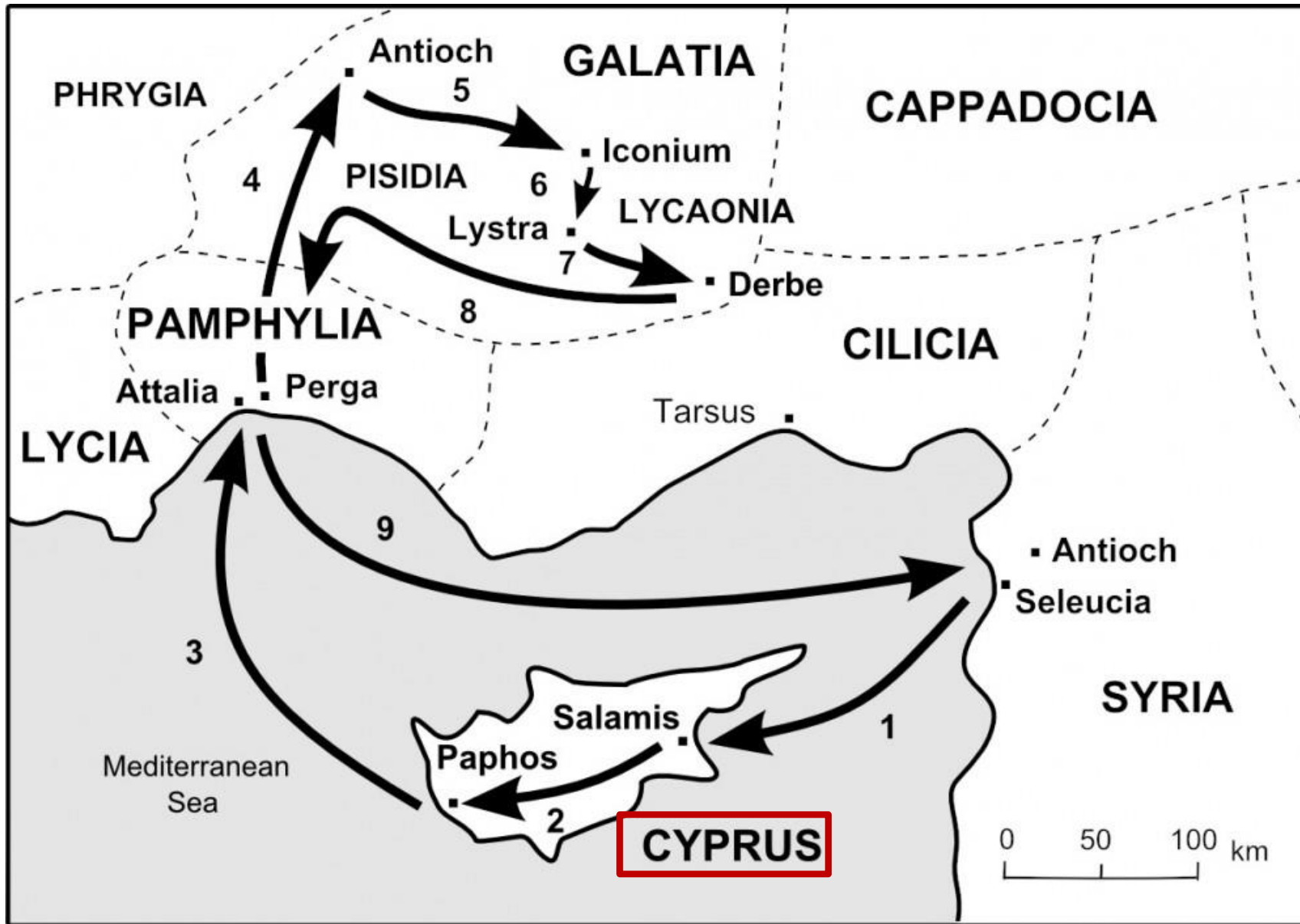

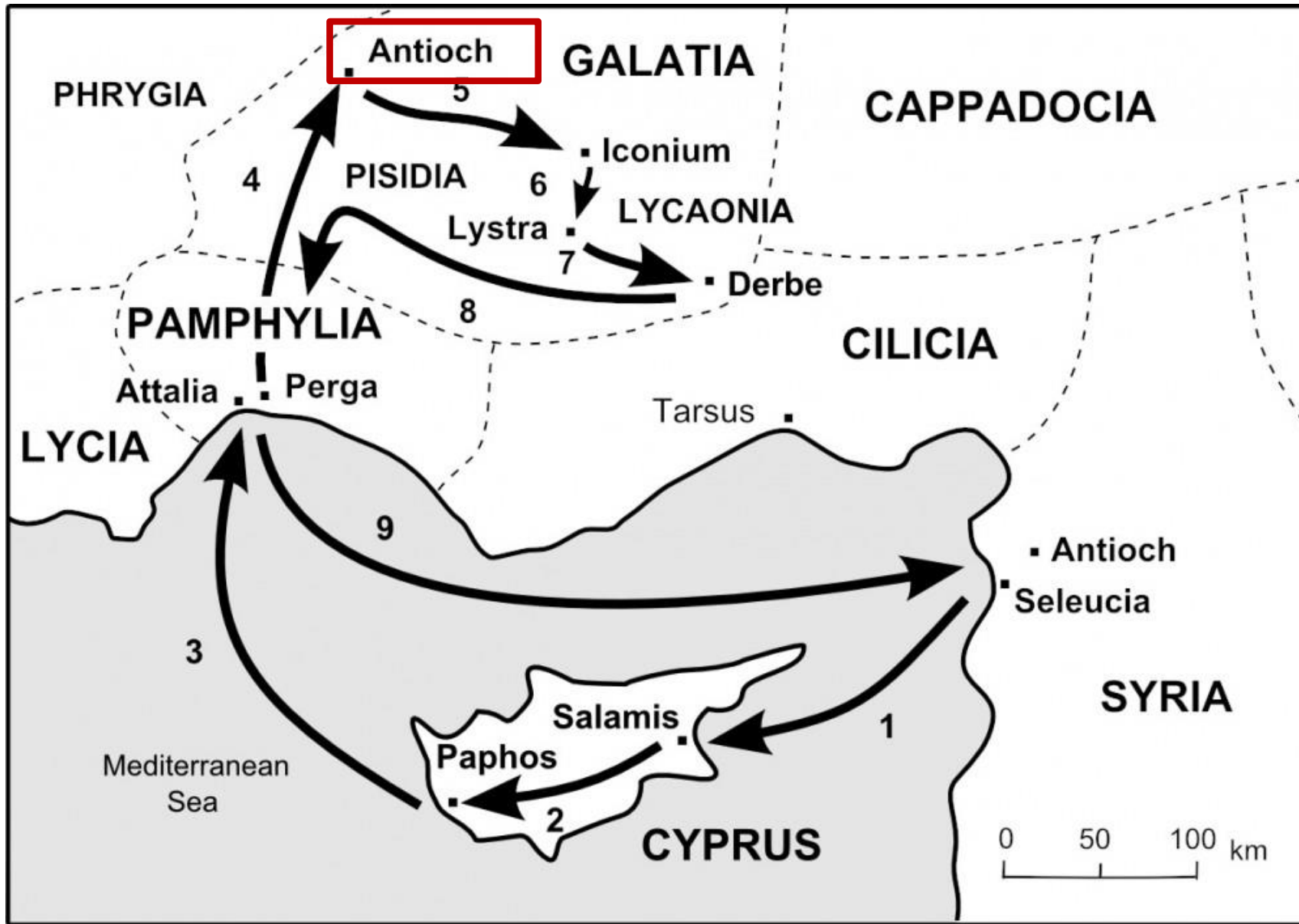

Sent as part of the greatest story (Pisidian Antioch)

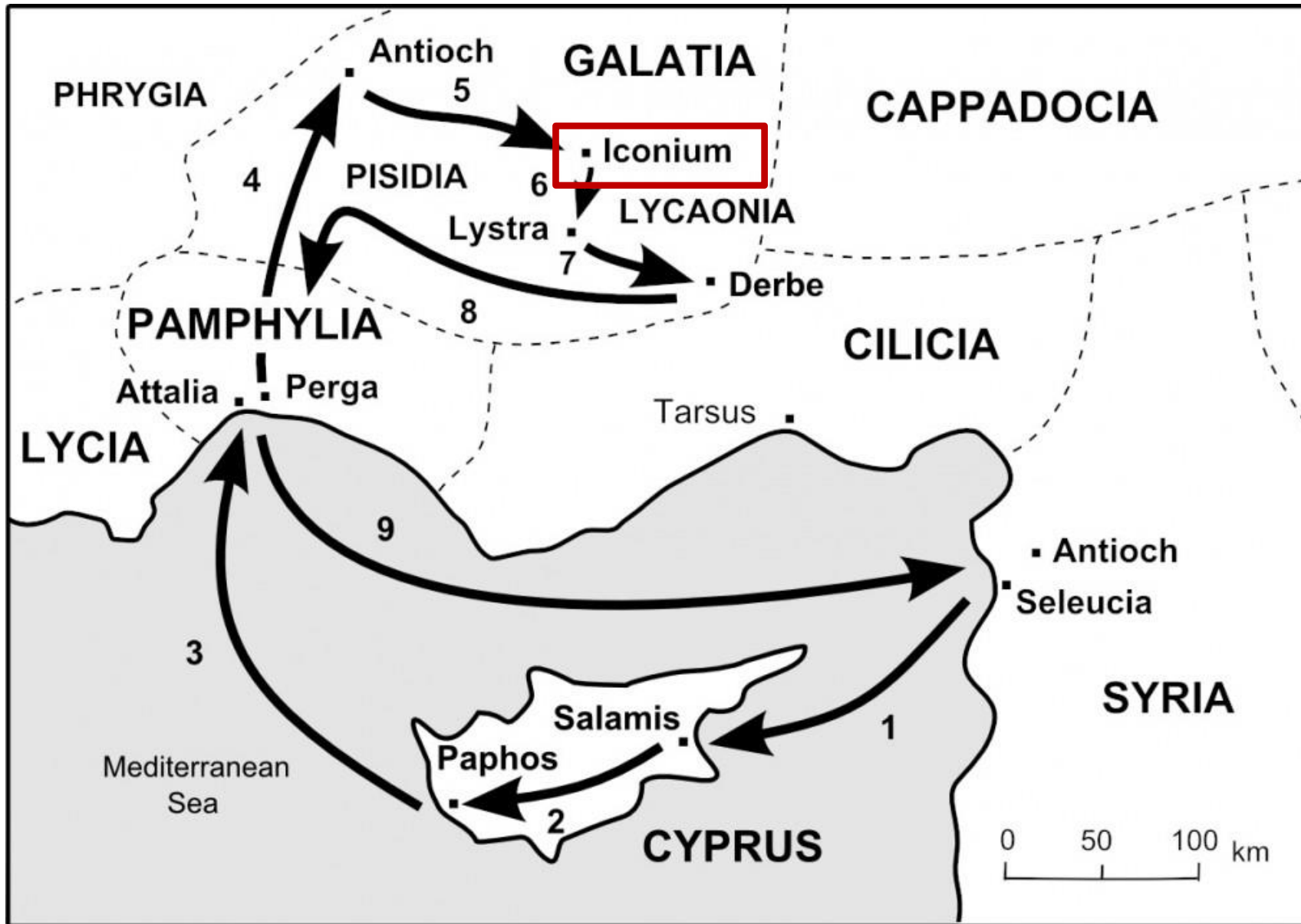
Beginning with Jewish and God-fearing community:

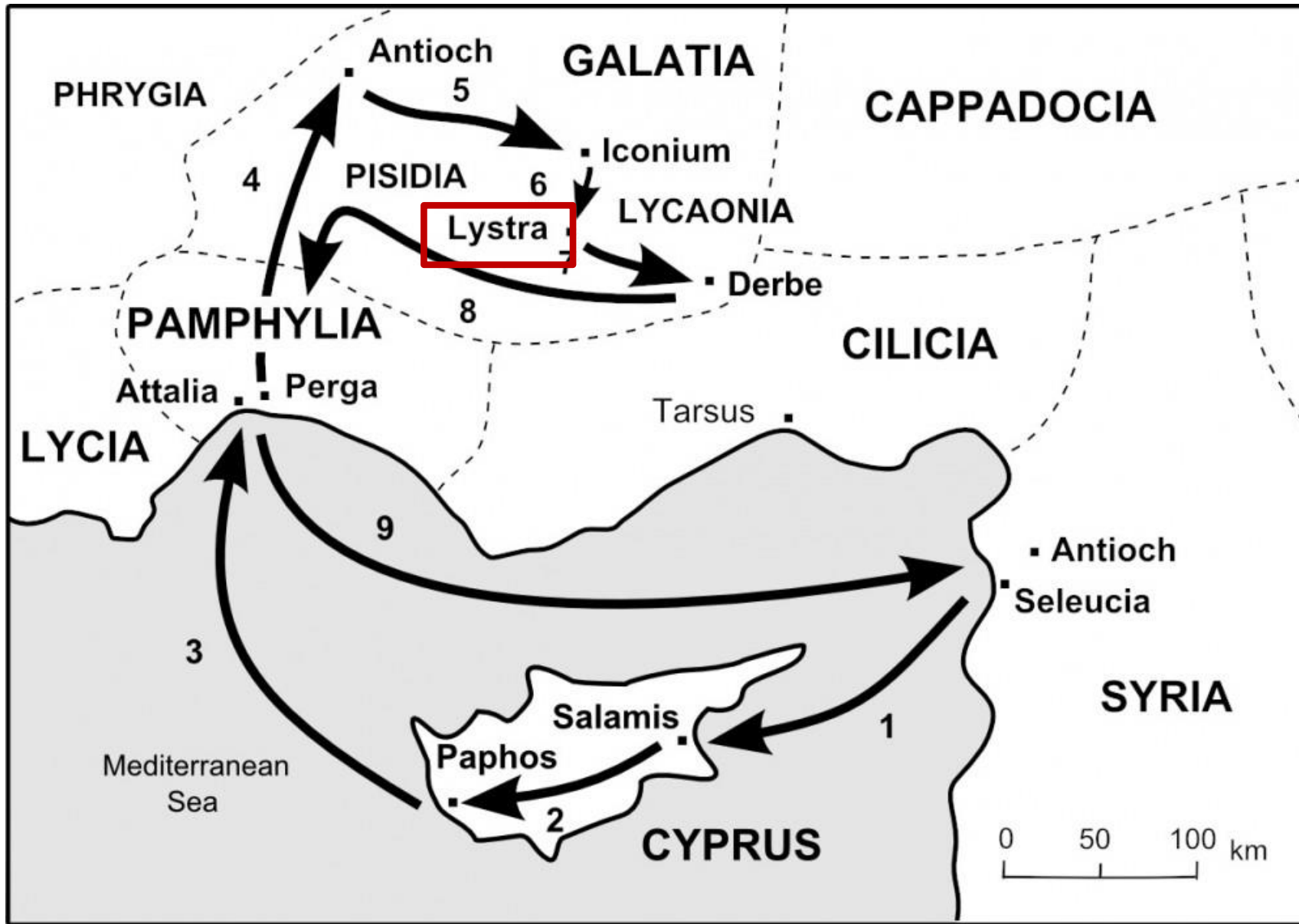

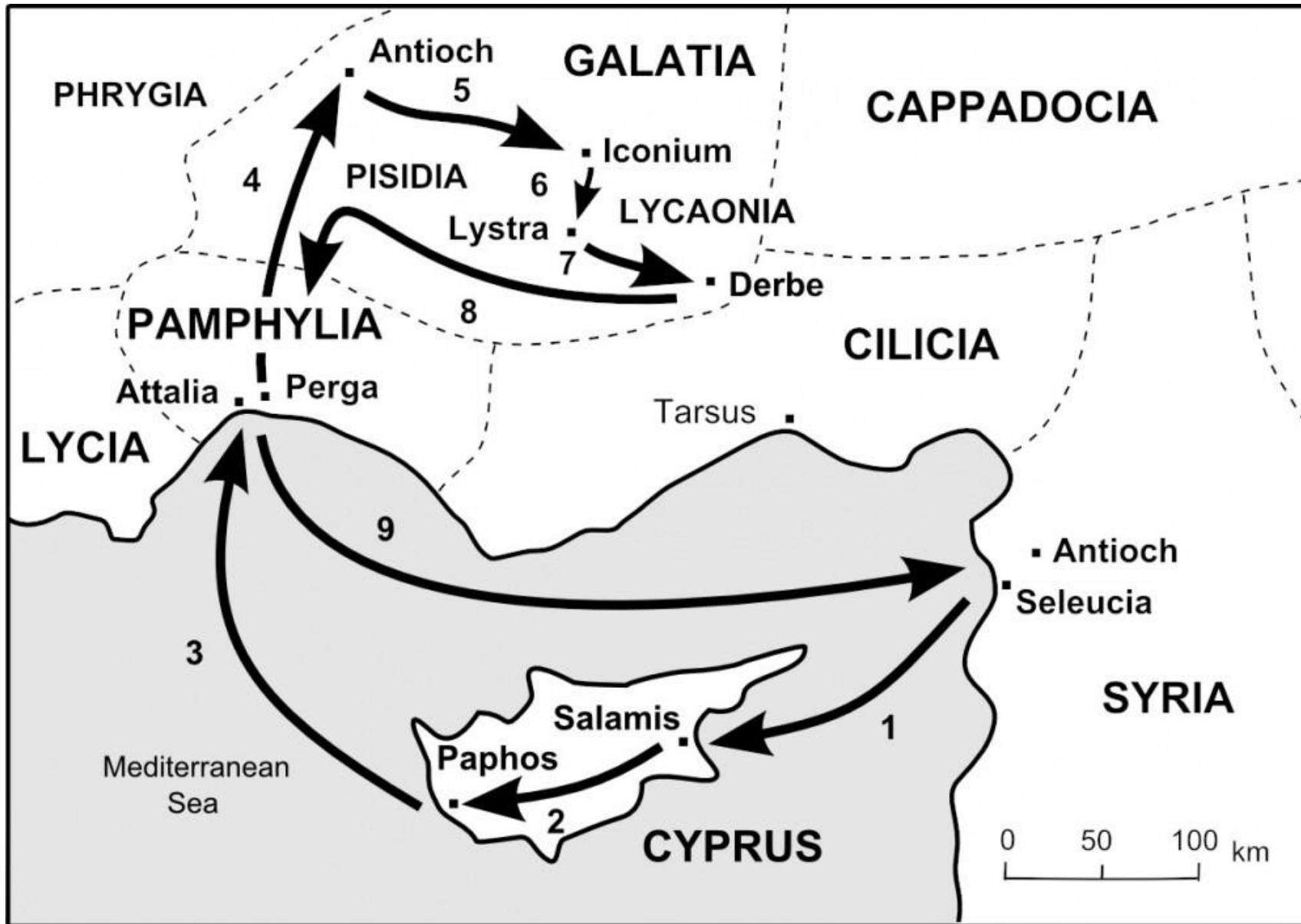
