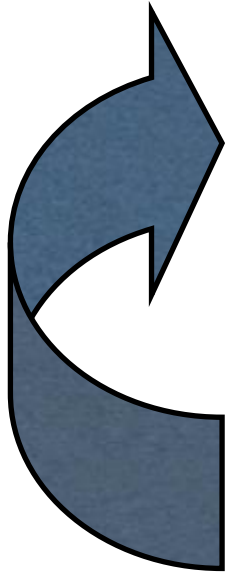

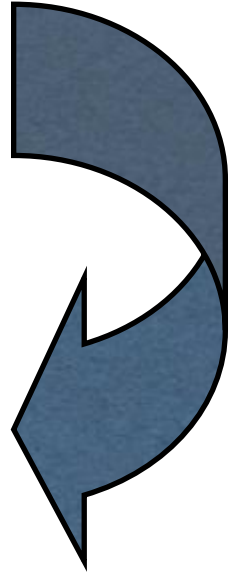
The Kingdom of God
