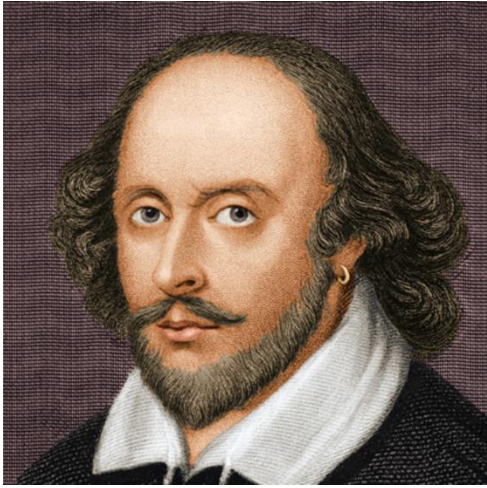
# Why live and speak for Jesus?

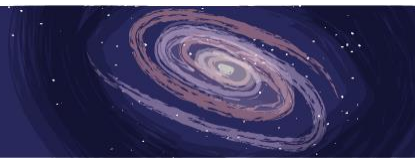
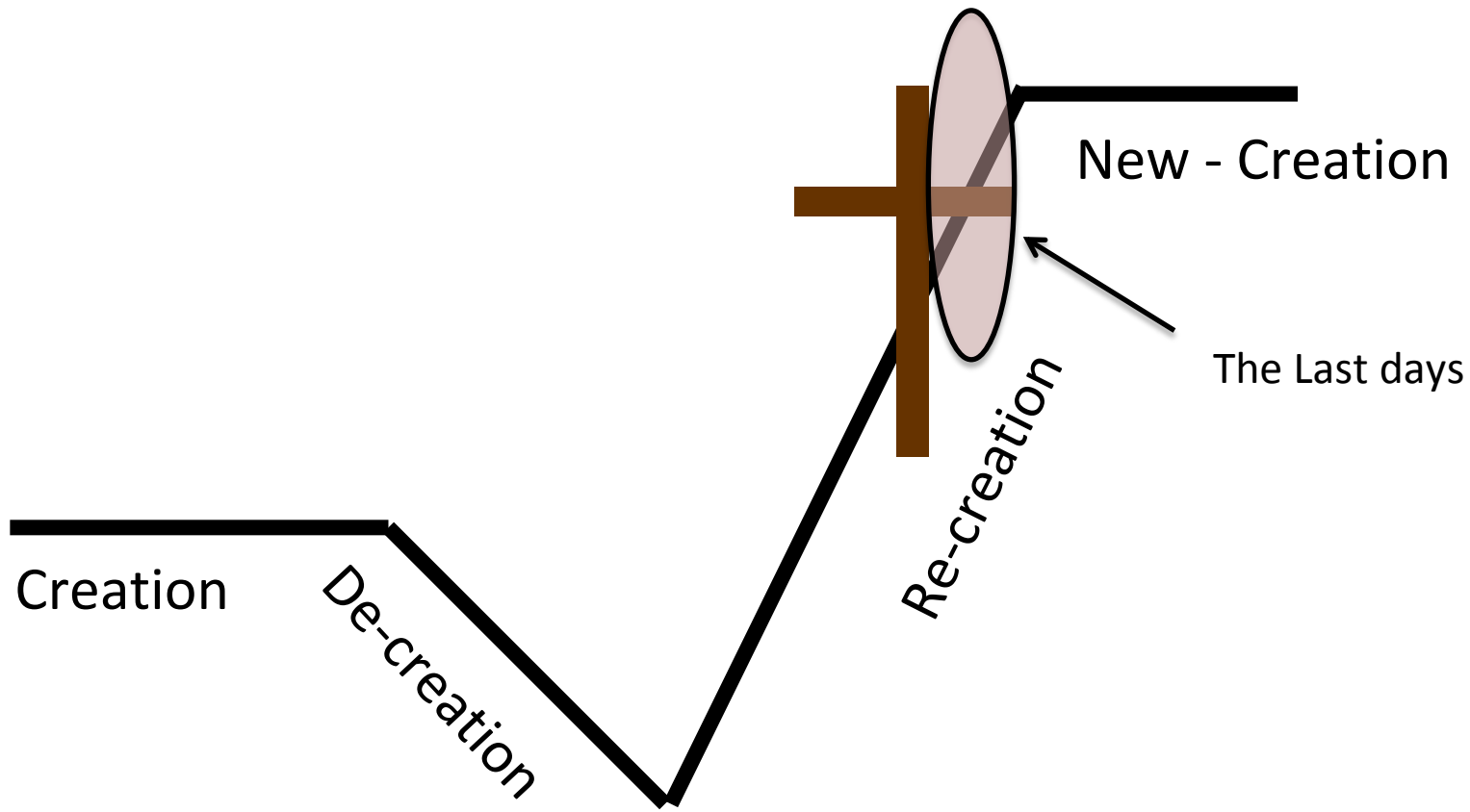
