- Take a lead in shepherding the flock at East, focussing mainly on more complex matters
- Envision and lead the East congregation in its outreach into Harefield and the East of the city
- Develop relationships with Woodlands Community College and explore areas of co-operation
- Foster good relationships with other local church and community leaders
- · As congregation grows over time, consider and make recommendations for future flourishing

Whole Church

- Participate in Above Bar Leadership Team and Eldership meetings
- Serve as member of the Preaching Team, contributing to the overall preaching programme
- Preach and teach at both sites to help maintain cohesion and shared vision between sites.
 Primarily to be based at the East site
- Be an active member of the Staff Team, regularly attending staff prayers and meetings
- Line manage some staff, details to be agreed
- Other whole church duties to be agreed according to capacity and gifting
